RULES OF THE FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT

1: ATTIRE IN THE COURTROOM:

- Modest apparel will be worn.
- NO tank tops, halters, shorts, or inappropriate headwear.
- Shirt tails will be tucked in at all times.
- Belts and suspenders will be properly secured.
- No inappropriate wearing of jewelry.

2: ORDER AND DECORUM IN THE COURTROOM:

- NO talking in the courtroom.
- Noisy children will be removed from the courtroom.
- When appearing before the judge, stand erect with your arms at your sides.
- NO unnecessary movement in and out of the courtroom.
- Everyone must be seated.

3: ITEMS NOT ALLOWED IN THE COURTROOM:

- WEAPONS OF ANY KIND
- Cell phones and pagers are to be turned OFF in the courtroom
- Food, Drinks, or Chewing gum
- Magazines, Books, or Newspapers while court is in session
- Video equipment, Tape recorders, or Cameras
